



anielle Bonello-Dunsford, founder and principal interior designer of Danielle Victoria Design Studio, was hired to overhaul an uninspiring and outdated kitchen, ensuite and powder room in this home on Sydney's lower north shore. The goal? Improve style and functionality, while increasing storage. "The clients wanted to share the cooking space and the existing kitchen didn't allow for this. By redesigning the layout, including adjusting distances between the prep and cooking zones, the whole room flows better and we could utilise every millimetre," says Danielle. A new pantry/small appliance cupboard with retractable doors provides essential extra storage; a bulkhead above the kitchen overhead cupboards conceals an air-conditioning unit that couldn't be relocated. Another major change Danielle made was bricking up an existing window that provided little light or views and extending the kitchen the entire length of the room. "We also redesigned the external French doors off the kitchen to draw more north-facing light inside," adds Danielle. Aesthetically, a minimal soft grey colour palette was chosen for its sophisticated air with a muted blue island serving as the centrepiece, and bronze and nickel accents by way of hardware and tapware bring overall lightness to the kitchen.

Design tip

According to Danielle, the key to creating a beautiful kitchen is carefully planned functionality and a balanced layout. "If you don't master the arrangement of appliances and the amount of circulation space to create a comfortable work zone, then you haven't resolved the brief," says Danielle.
